CHINAR Kashmir

INTRODUCTION:

Child Nurture and Relief Kashmir (CHINAR Kashmir) is a Non-Governmental Organization (NGO) working for the welfare of destitute children and their families.

CHINAR Kashmir (CK) is based in Jammu and Kashmir and is active since 2004. We have since then continued our work with aim of reaching out to the needy without compromising the quality of the work, with accountability and transparency as its key.

CK runs several programs which ensure education for destitute children, and providing material assistance to needy families and economic empowerment of youth especially women.

OUR PROGRAMMES:

1. CHINAR HOME PROGRAMME (CHP):

This is a Home for destitute children especially orphans who are taken care of in a familial environment and are provided with quality education in good private schools besides inhouse tuition by CK.

The intake capacity of CHINAR Kashmir (CK) Home = 48 children Total no. of children currently enrolled at CK Home = 41

We ensure that every child at CK Home gets all the basic facilities of life like good food, proper health care and exposure to such activities where their hidden talents are identified and honed by CK team.



2. Remote Child Sponsorship Programme (RCSP):

Under this programme, the educational/financial assistance to the needy children up to class 12th is ensured based on regular progress updates and assessment. CK aims to reach out to the most destitute families who have no or meagre source of income to sustain their families. Intervention by CK helps children of such families to continue their studies at least till 12th class.

CHINAR Kashmir under RCSP provides students with monthly monetary help to support basic necessities like food and medicine. CK also provides Summer/Winter School Uniform, Stationary and Books, School Fee, Bus Fee, Tuition Fee, School Bags, Casual clothing (Twice a year).

Total no. of students currently enrolled = 100

3. Scholarship, Training and Education Programme for Undergraduates and Postgraduates (STEP-UP)

<u>Programme:</u> CHINAR Kashmir helps students belonging to underprivileged families to continue / complete their higher education under this programme. The focus is to support those students who are pursuing technical / professional courses like MBBS, B.Tech, BCA, BBA, Electrical Engineering, B.Sc. Nursing, Female Multi-Purpose Health Worker (FMPHW) etc. within and outside J&K. With the help of CK, students got financial support at the time of need and they were able to continue their studies, hence able to dream big in their field of interest.

18 beneficiaries were supported in year 2022.

4. Skills Enhancement and Entrepreneurship Development (SEED) Programme:

Under this programme, training in marketable vocational trades like cutting and tailoring, is provided to girls/women. This allows them to sharpen their abilities, empower themselves by honing their skills and earn a livelihood, which transforms their lives and of their families.

No. of training centre's currently functional = 11 Total no. of girls/women trained in year 2022 = 150



5. Giving Housing and Relief (GHAR) Programme:

Under this Programme those poor and destitute families are provided financial assistance for their houses, who don't have a proper roof over their head and for those also; who have a house



but don't have basic amenities essential for a dignified living, suitable for the harsh winters of Kashmir.

The first & foremost beneficiaries for GHAR programme are the families of children sponsored either through RCSP or CHP.

7 families provided help in the year 2022

6. Relief & Rehabilitation (R&R) Programme:

This programme came into existence when JK witnessed devastating earthquake in the year 2005.

CK through this programme have extensively helped people at the time of natural / man-made disasters. Apart from that, CK has also helped needy people with food kits, Sadqa-e-Fitr, monetary help for medicines, living expenses, etc., from time to time. In the year 2022:

- * Medical help provided to 4 terminally ill patients
- * 2 families provided monetary assistance for their houses damaged by fire.
- * Food kits provided to 200 needy families.
- * Living expenses provided in the form of monthly monetary assistance to 159 needy families particularly women headed families (widows/divorcees) during winter season (Nov 22 Feb 23).
