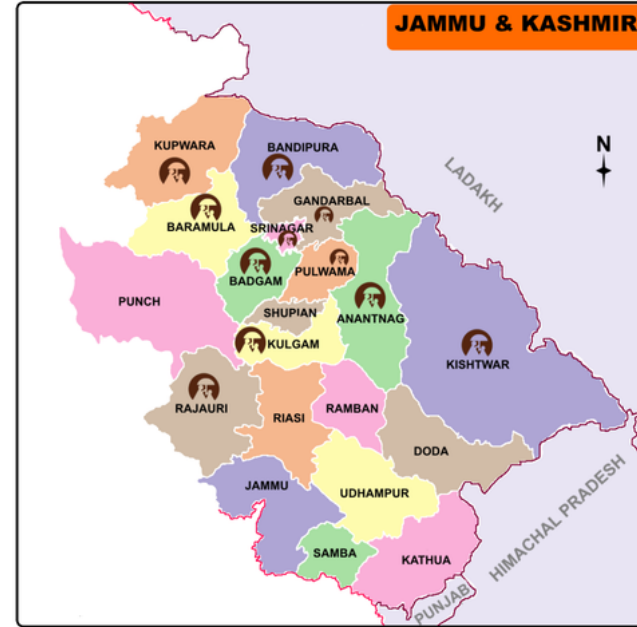

- **Monthly Assistance:** Eight Families for Sustainable Food Supply
